How can I reset the IF-002 to its factory default settings?



Note: For Modbus RTU Operation the Modbus Address must be unique, Databits must equal 8, Stopbits must be set to 1.

How can I reset the IF-002 to its factory default settings?

Step 1: Power off the IF-002 by disconnecting it from your Modbus Network.

Step 2: Unplug any smart probe connected to your IF-002.

Step 3: Short pins 3 and 4 on the 8-pin connector on the IF-002.



Step 4: Apply power to the IF-002 for 3 seconds from the 5-pin connector.

Step 5: Remove short from pins 3 and 4.

Step 6: Reconnect your Layer N Smart Probe and apply power.

What settings should my IF-002 be set to for a firmware update?

 The IF-002 must be reset to its factory default settings prior to a firmware update.

LED Status Signals

The following LED Status Signals provide a visual indication of the device state and communications activity.

Color	Status
OFF	No power.
YELLOW	Communications in progress.
RED - 1 second flash	A short condition has been detected on the sensor power circuitry.
RED - 1/4 second flash	A message to the device was not acknowledged.
GREEN	After power up the GREEN LED remains on solid while power is available to the device. It will turn OFF during error reporting.

Serial Terminal Configuration

Note: These instructions are for configuring Note your IF-002 through a Serial Terminal. For configuration through SYNC, please refer to the section titled SYNC Configuration.

Once your IF-002 is connected to your computer running a Serial Terminal, you may begin configuring your device.

To set the Modbus Address on your IF-002, use the following command:

O(ptions) M(odbusAddr) = X

Example of how to set the Modbus Address to 5:

O M = 5



Serial commands should be entered in the same line and can be separated by a comma. Use the following table and example to set your serial configuration:

Serial	Configuration Options
B(audrate)	9600 19200 38400 115200
P(arity)	Even Odd Mark None
D(atabits)	7 8
S(top)	1 2

Note: Mark Parity is currently not supported.

To set the Serial configuration options on your IF-002, use the following command:

S(erial) B(audrate) = X, P(arity) = X, D(atabits) = X, S(top) = X

Example of how to set the Serial configuration options:

S B = 115200, P = Even, D = 8, S = 1

To reset the IF-002 serial configuration to default, type the following command:

S R

Once your IF-002 is configured, you can integrate your Layer N Smart Probe to your Modbus Network.

SYNC Configuration

Note: These instructions are for configuring your IF-002 through SYNC configuration software.

Step 1: Connect a Smart Probe to the M12 8-Pin connector IF-002.

Step 2: Connect the IF-002 to the host computer.

Step 3: Once your IF-002 has been auto-detected by SYNC, click Device Settings.

> Note: SYNC will only auto-detect your IF-002 when it is in its default settings. Please refer to the Troubleshooting section for information on how to factory reset your device

Step 4: Click Set Serial Port.

Step 5: Set serial port parameters for your IF-002 and click Save.
